**** Dish mounting OK
on large trim**

*** Wrong placement**

*** Correct placement of the junction box must be under the house to hide all of these unsightly wires.**

**** The dish is mounted correctly.**

The dish should never be mounted on the siding.

Wiring must run under the house front to back, and not along the side of the unit. Wiring is not allowed on the roof or over the gutters. Exterior wiring must be attached to the large trim board and not the siding.


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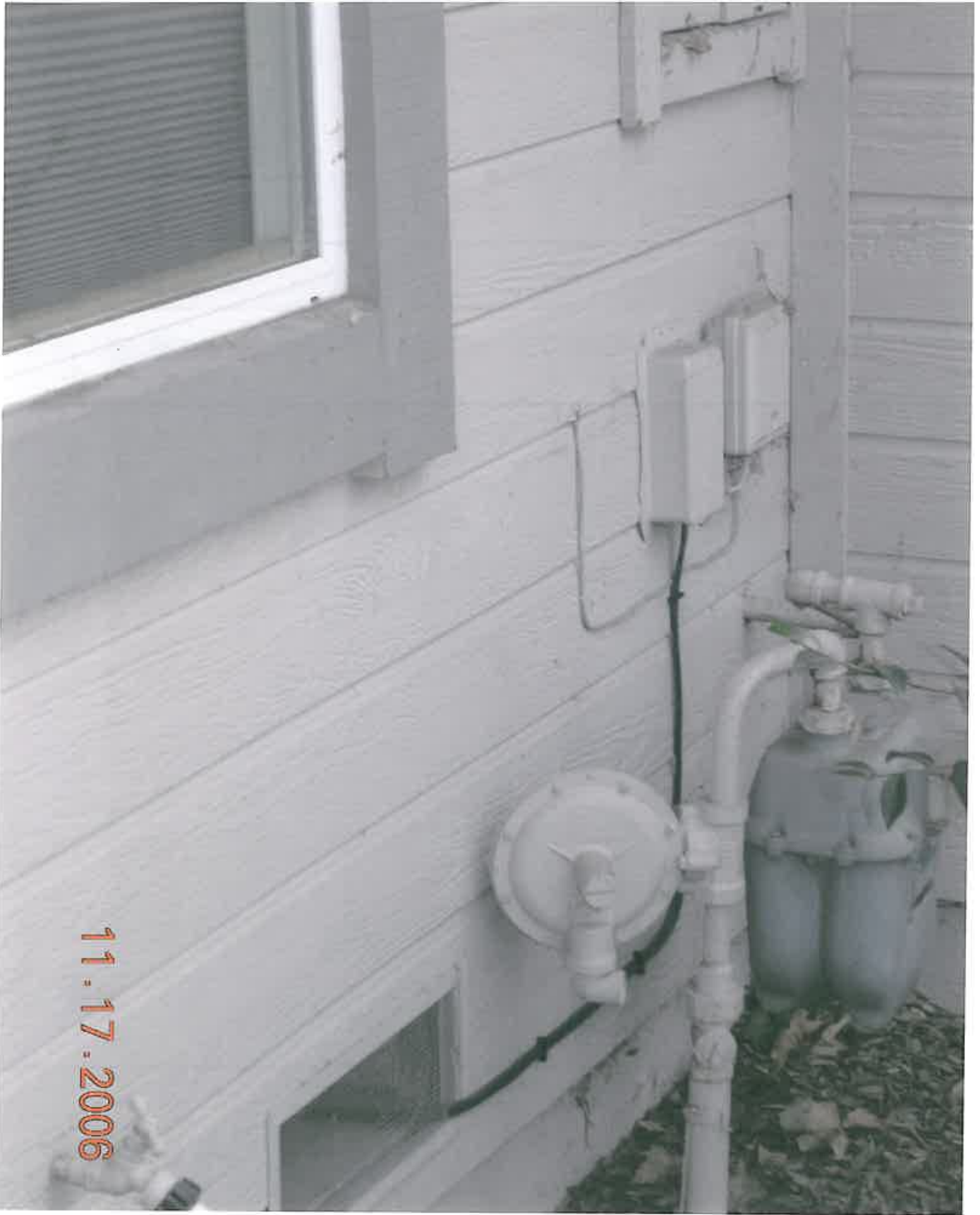
Wiring is tucked behind trim board. Out of sight. Dish is mounted to large trim board correctly.
